## My Literacy / My communication

Art inspired by journeys, animals, and nature.  
Exploring collage and outdoor materials. Linked to Earth Day and Eid.  
Creating memory books and celebration art. Making Father's Day cards and end-of-year displays

## Numeracy

### Time and Money

- Exploring daily routines and visual timetables.
- Using coins in role-play shops and snack time.
  - Understanding before/after, now/next.
- Festive Link: Using coins and clocks in Eid or Earth Day themed activities.

### Consolidation and Practical Application

- Applying number, shape, and measure skills in real-life contexts.
  - Participating in outdoor numeracy trails and games.
- Celebrating progress with numeracy-themed activities.
  - Festive Link: Counting down to summer holidays, Father's Day number crafts.
