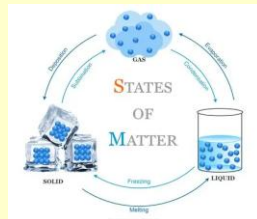
Novel: The Seeing Stone by Kevin Crossley-Holland

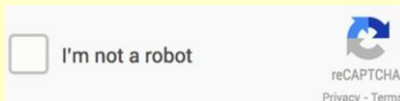
